

- What migration and settlement patterns helped determine that Missouri would want to enter the 2. Union as a slave state?
- What impact did the manner in which states were previously admitted to the Union have on the 3. reaction to the admission of Missouri?
- Why would the South accept the Missouri Compromise? What does this tell you about the nature 4. of the plantation system and attitudes toward the institution of slavery and its ability to expand?
- What potential existed as a result of the Missouri Compromise for an eventual upsetting of the 5. balance between slave and free states? Which section seemed to gain the most from this?
- How did the Missouri Compromise reflect the tensions between political parties at the time, 6. especially tensions that were the result of the expansion of the nation?
